FINDING DIGITAL IMAGES

As a patron of the Gund Library, you have access to several web-based, subscription image databases. These should be your first stop as they contain high quality images. Some require you to access them from on campus, others can be accessed off campus once you set up an account or have the login information. The Internet is a good source for images, and using a search engine is an easy way to look for reproductions of artworks. If you know what museum owns a specific work of art, it might be best to locate that museum's web site and then search for the art object.

FINDING REPRODUCTIONS IN THE IMAGE COLLECTION

To locate a slide of a specific artist's or designer's work in the slide collection, look for the artist's or designer's last name in the slide artist file. Ask the library staff for help.

To locate a digital image in the library's MDID collection, visit <http://slide.cia.edu/> from on campus. You need to ask the Image Librarian for an account first.

FINDING REPRODUCTIONS OF AN ART WORK IN THE CLEVELAND MUSEUM OF ART
