## Websites

The Internet is a good place to look for information on specific grants, internships, residencies, and scholarships, but be cautious of sites that make you pay to register or ask for detailed personal information to use. The two websites listed below bring together a wealth of useful information and are recommended sites for starting your research.

**Foundation Center** (<http://foundationcenter.org>) with its comprehensive listing of US grants has plenty of information for visitors without paid subscriptions such as its free “reference guides” (<http://foundationcenter.org/getstarted/guides/artists.html>) and free guides, tutorials & webinars <http://foundationcenter.org/getstarted/learnabout/proposalwriting.html>
