The Cleveland Institute of Art Creative Writing Concentration

This program concentrates the study of narrative, literature, and creative writing for students who want to focus a portion of their degree credit on advancing their creative writing skills and producing a body of written work.

Program Entrance and standing requirements:

Students with a Career GPA of 3.30 or higher may apply to become CRW Concentrators by submitting a portfolio by the application date in the fall of their sophomore year. Students must maintain a GPA of 3.00 in their CRW Concentration courses in order to remain in the program.

Course Requirements:

One Foundation Narrative Course (Narrative Forms) will fulfill three hours of credit in the Concentration; Three upper-division electives (9 credit hours) are dedicated to the program of study. The capstone course for concentrators (3 credit hours) is a cross-genre workshop in which students develop their final "Body of Work." The content of each "Body of Work" can be developed from drafts the student has written during coursework leading up to the capstone course. Each "Body of Work" packet will include a short critical introduction as preface.

It is the responsibility of the concentrator to obtain all signatures and keep this form up to date.
